

MOLINE TOWNSHIP
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING
APRIL 12TH, 2022

Moline Township Clerk, Theresa Oak, opened the 2022 Moline Township Annual Town Meeting in the Moline Township Hall, 620 - 18th St, Moline, IL 61265 @ 6:01pm.

The Township Clerk lead the Pledge of Allegiance, and confirmed that 13 electors/voters from the Township were present. A motion was made by Bonnie Johnson with a second by Hayleigh Covella to accept the number of electors/voters present. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The Township Clerk called for a motion for the nomination of a moderator. A motion was moved to nominate Aubrey Etheridge as Moderator by Abbie Hakemian with a second from Bonnie Johnson. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The Township Clerk administered the Oath of Moderator to Aubrey Etheridge.

Moderator, Aubrey Etheridge, confirmed the Agenda & Notice of Meeting which was posted in 3 different locations. The Moderator also confirmed that the electors/voters all had copies of the Agenda and Notice of Meeting for their review.

The Minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held on April 13th, 2021 were reviewed. Bonnie Johnson with a second from Hayleigh Covella moved for a motion to accept as read. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Moderator, Aubrey Etheridge, presented the Supervisor's Annual Financial Statement and read the beginning, ending and total balances of each fund. Abbie Hakemian with a second from Derek Devers moved for a motion to approve. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Derek Devers moved with a second from Staci Early for a Resolution for setting the time of the 2023 Annual Town Meeting to be held @ 6:01 pm on April 11th, 2023. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

There was no old business.
There was no new business.

Public Comments: Informed audience that each person had five minutes to speak.
Christian Umbarger voiced his disappointment in the Township for not putting the following items on the Annual Agenda:

- Do you support reallocating public funding from law enforcement to social services?
- Do you support a nationalized Medicare for all in the United States?
- Do you support municipalities establishing rent control over housing?

Jenna Isabell voiced she was disheartened at the fact the advisory questions didn't make the agenda.

Ian Nelson questioned the legal process for Agenda items and was disappointed.

There being no other business to discuss at this 2022 Annual Town Meeting. Bonnie Johnson moved for a motion with a second from Hayleigh Covella to adjourn. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote. The meeting adjourned @ 6:16 pm.
