Filers and families who made \$57,000 or less in the last year can schedule an appointment for Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) being provided by United Way. Services will be available to residents of Scott and Rock Island Counties from January 26th to April 15th.

For a scheduled appointment, they ask that

you bring the following items:

- Valid driver's license or photo ID
- Social Security Card or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN) for all members in your family
- All W-2 forms
- Prior year tax return
- All 1099 forms (if applicable)
- Account numbers for electronic deposit of refund
- Health insurance documentation
 If filing jointly, your spouse must be present
